self-financing. Total running costs for 05/06, are forecast at being £2400. However, the free water supply that all Village Hall's have been enjoying comes to an end in April 06. It is estimated that this could be as much as £800/year. That will make the task of making the hall self-financing all the harder to achieve. The committee are investigating options, including water metering to minimise the impact of the water charge.

The key to the success of the hall ever more relies on the regular user groups. The committee are grateful to all the people who put activities on for the village, in the hall. We are also grateful for all the people who then support these activities. It is obvious that if people don't commit and attend these activities then the financial burden becomes harder to achieve.

A hall grounds clearing, weeding, tidying day occurred on 5<sup>th</sup> June. A great effort was made, thanks to all adults and children who helped. Parents, can I request that you tell your children not to throw stones obtained from the hall borders onto the roof or into the roadway, car parks and pavements; in addition please ask them to act in an appropriate manner when activities are being held in the hall.

Since the last newsletter we have ran a successful 'Pamper night' at the end of May. 40 adults and children attended the event. The sum of £252 was raised. Grateful thanks to the 2 main organisers, Emma Farrer and Jo Appleton. Also many thanks to the contributors and to all who attended. In contrast the Spring Ceilidh had to be cancelled due to lack of interest, demonstrated through advance ticket sales.

The next major event is the Summer Games on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> July. In addition to the sports activities we are running a few other activities to raise money for the hall.

I'm looking forward to the day and hoping that good fun and enjoyment will be had by all.

### Hall Booking & Charges

Events, including charitable/fundraising events, are charged at standard rates, as follows:

1. Evening functions (Friday and Saturday): £60.00 + £60.00 refundable deposit.
2. Children's parties/Special functions during the daytime (up to 6pm): £30.00 + £30.00 refundable deposit.
3. All other hire: £6.00 per hour or part thereof.

Payment of the deposit is mandatory and it is to be paid at the same time as the hire charge, 14 days prior to the function.

### Table and Chair Hire

Anyone wishing to borrow chairs or tables from the hall for functions at home may hire them for £2 per table and £1 per chair.

### Church of Scotland Services

Ecumenical services are held at 5pm on the last Sunday of each month in the Hall (5.30pm on 28<sup>th</sup> August).
